SPEYSIDE

Located in the North East of Scotland, surrounding the river Spey, Speyside is the most densely populated whisky region with over 50 distilleries. Speyside single malts are regarded as some of the most elegant and complex in all of Scotland.

ISLAY

Scotland's southernmost part of the Inner Hebrides, Islay, is truly in a league of its own. A unique makeup of peat on the island provides Islay malts with unmistakable notes of smoke & brine on the nose giving away multi-layered and complex flavours on the palate. This complexity is why Islay malts are often regarded as the best in Scotland.

AUSTRALIA

Australian whisky was popularised globally in 2014 when Sullivan's Cove French Oak Single Cask won the world's best single malt whisky at the World Whiskies Awards. This was the first time a distillery outside of Scotland or Japan had won this category. Today, Australia produces a range of styles- single malt, rye, wheat and blended whisky which feature a vast array of finishes, flavour profiles and complexity which sees Australian whisky winning awards year on year.

AMERICA

American Whiskey has had some tough times, after battling prohibition in the 20's and 30's but has since seen a strong resurgence ever since. There are currently over 2000 distilleries operating in the United States producing bourbon, rye, corn, wheat, malt and Tennessee whiskies. Each spirit must contain at least 51% of it's first listed grain and also must be aged in virgin American oak barrels.

IRELAND

The first recorded Irish whiskey dates back to 1405, some 90 years before it was recorded in Scotland. Irish whiskey was once the most popular spirit in the world, though a long period of decline from the late 19th century onwards greatly damaged the industry. Ireland boasted at least 28 distilleries in the 1890s, by 1966 this number had fallen to just two, and by 1972 the remaining distilleries were Bushmills Distillery and Old Middleton Distillery. Since the 1990s, Irish whiskey has seen a resurgence in popularity and has been the fastest-growing spirit in the world every year since 1990.

JAPAN

Commercial whisky production began in Japan in the early 1920's by Masataka Taketsuru after he returned from Scotland, bringing back a wealth of knowledge. Japanese whisky is therefore grounded in Scotch techniques but over the years has been combined with new Japanese techniques which results in the delicately balanced, rich, complex and elegant style we have come to know today.
